## **ACS meets International Trade Centre**



The Directorate for Cooperation and Resource Mobilisation (DCRM), under the stewardship of Director Ingrid Jacobs, and the Directorate for Trade and Sustainable Development (DTSD), under the stewardship of Director Safiya Horne-Bique of the Association of Caribbean States, held a meeting today with the Chief, Special Projects Office of the Executive Director for the International Trade Centre (ITC), Mr. Matthew Anthony Wilson, as well as Senior Advisor, Robertha Reid, and International Consultant, William Castro.

During the meeting, ITC and ACS discussed potential avenues of cooperation, and exchanged their experiences in the areas of MSME's, sustainable tourism, community-based tourism, youth entrepreneurship, women economic growth, connecting value chains, e-commerce, and digital trade. In addition, ITC provided information in regards to their Trade Market Tools which contributes enormously to the process of researching and studying in the areas mentioned above at all global levels.
