DATE AND VENUE OF THE FIFTH SUMMIT OF HEADS OF STATE AND/OR GOVERNMENT OF THE ASSOCIATION OF CARIBBEAN STATES

The Ministerial Council,

Pursuant to:

Article VI, of the Convention Establishing the Association of Caribbean States;

Considering:

The principles and objectives of the ACS enshrined in the Preamble and Article III of the Convention Establishing the ACS;

That the First Summit of Heads of State and Representatives of the ACS was held in Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, on August 17-18, 1995;

That the Second Summit of Heads of State and/or Government of the ACS was held in Santo Domingo de Guzmán, Dominican Republic, on April 16-17, 1999;

That the Third Summit of Heads of State and/or Government of the ACS was held in Margarita Island, Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, on December 10-11, 2001;

That the Fourth Summit of Heads of State and/or Government of the ACS was held in Panama City, Panama, on July 29, 2005;

The offer of the Government of the Republic of Haiti under the auspices of His Excellency Michel Martelly, President of the Republic of Haiti, on the occasion of

the Seventeenth Ordinary Meeting of the Ministerial Council, to host the Fifth Summit of Heads of State and/or Government of the ACS;

AGREES:

To accept the invitation of the Government of the Republic of Haiti to hold the Fifth Summit of Heads of State and/or Government of the ACS, in Haiti, in the month of July, 2012.
